Training modes

Self-paced e-course	Short, self-directed on-line professional development course that combines text with multimedia, including videos and podcasts
Tutored e-learning course	E-learning course with an instructor and facilitator typically six or 11 weeks in duration (30-50 hours)
MOOC	Massive open online courses accessible to anyone
Training workshop	Face-to-face workshop typically three or four days in duration
Training workshop/blended	Training workshop preceded by a self-paced e-course
Blended learning	Tutored e-learning course followed by a field experience
Tailored	Aside from open enrollment courses and training HREA also offers on-demand e-learning and face-to-face training tailored to institutional needs

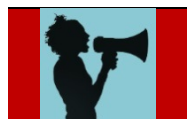

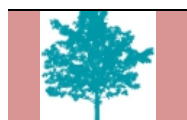
